Viewing Captions... in Windows Media Player – Version 10

To view **captions** (see example below) follow these instructions to set up your Windows Media Player. [Next slide](#)

Note, once you have completed this set-up, you must restart the video stream by closing Windows Media Player and then restarting. Upon restart, use the Ctrl+Shift+C command to show / hide captions.

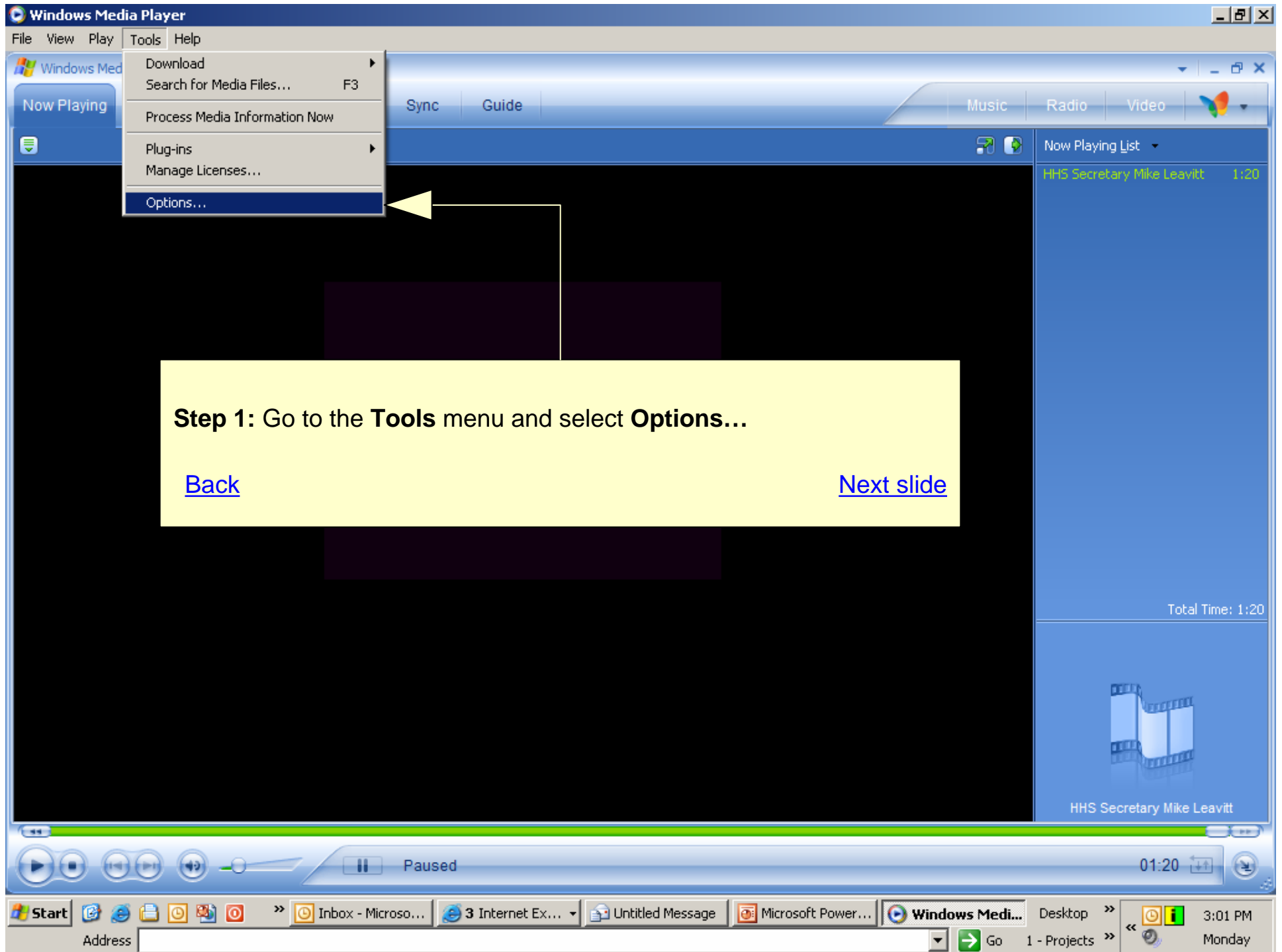

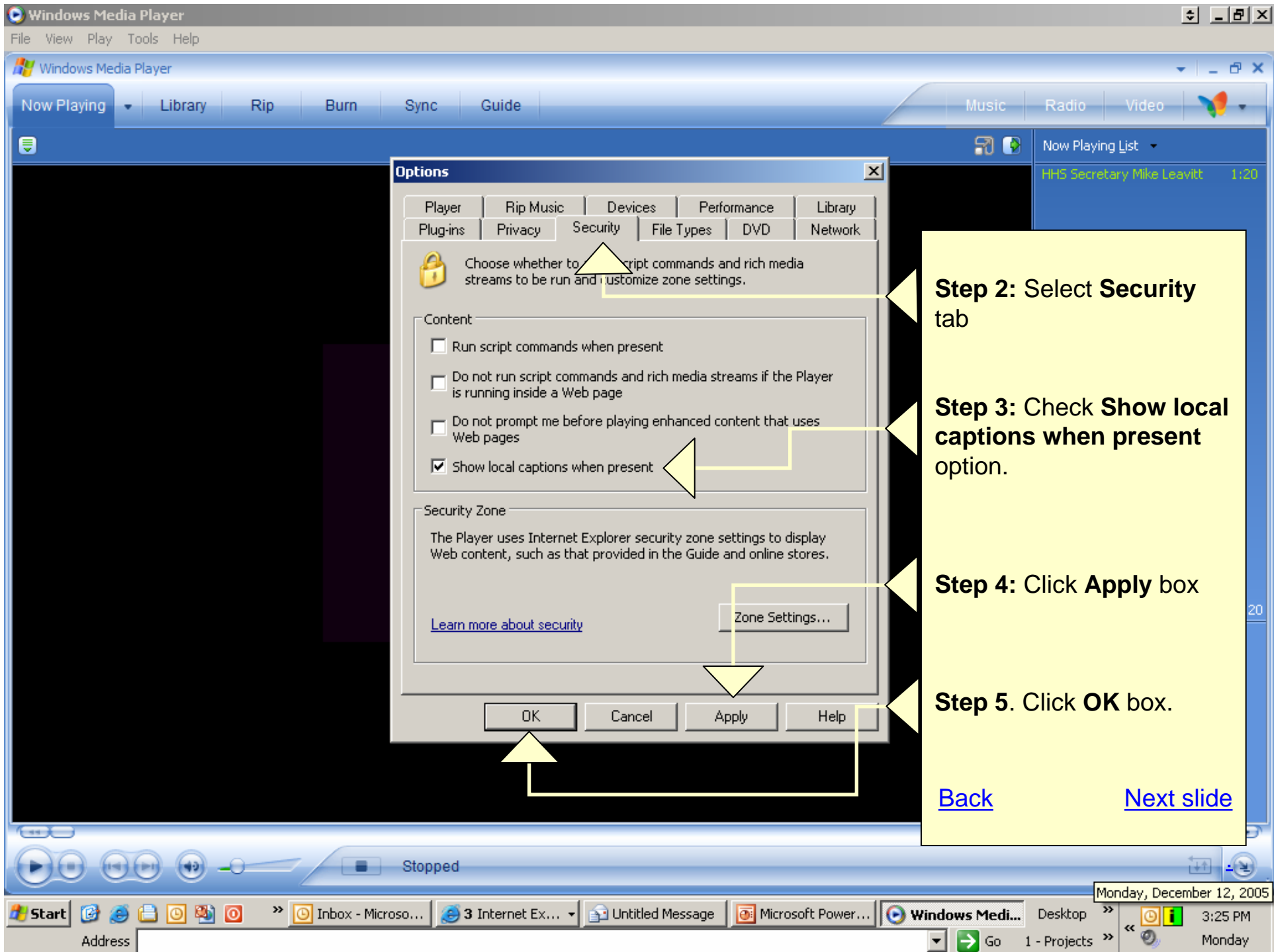

Step 6: Under the **Play** menu, select **Captions and Subtitles > English** option. If the **<English>** option is not visible, change the **Default** to **English**. See more on [changing default setting](#).

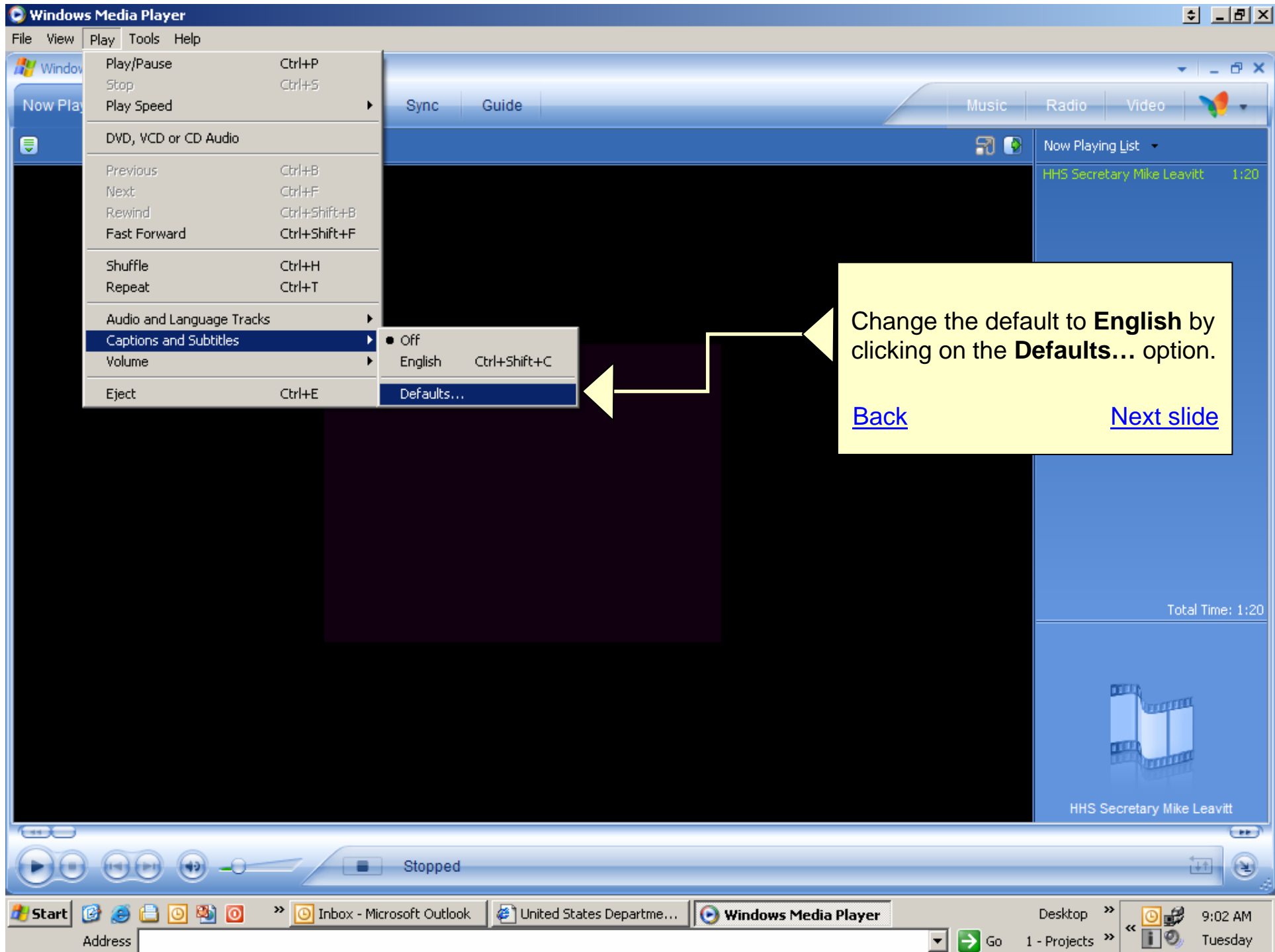
Step 7: **Close** and **restart** your Windows Media Player.

You should now see captions.

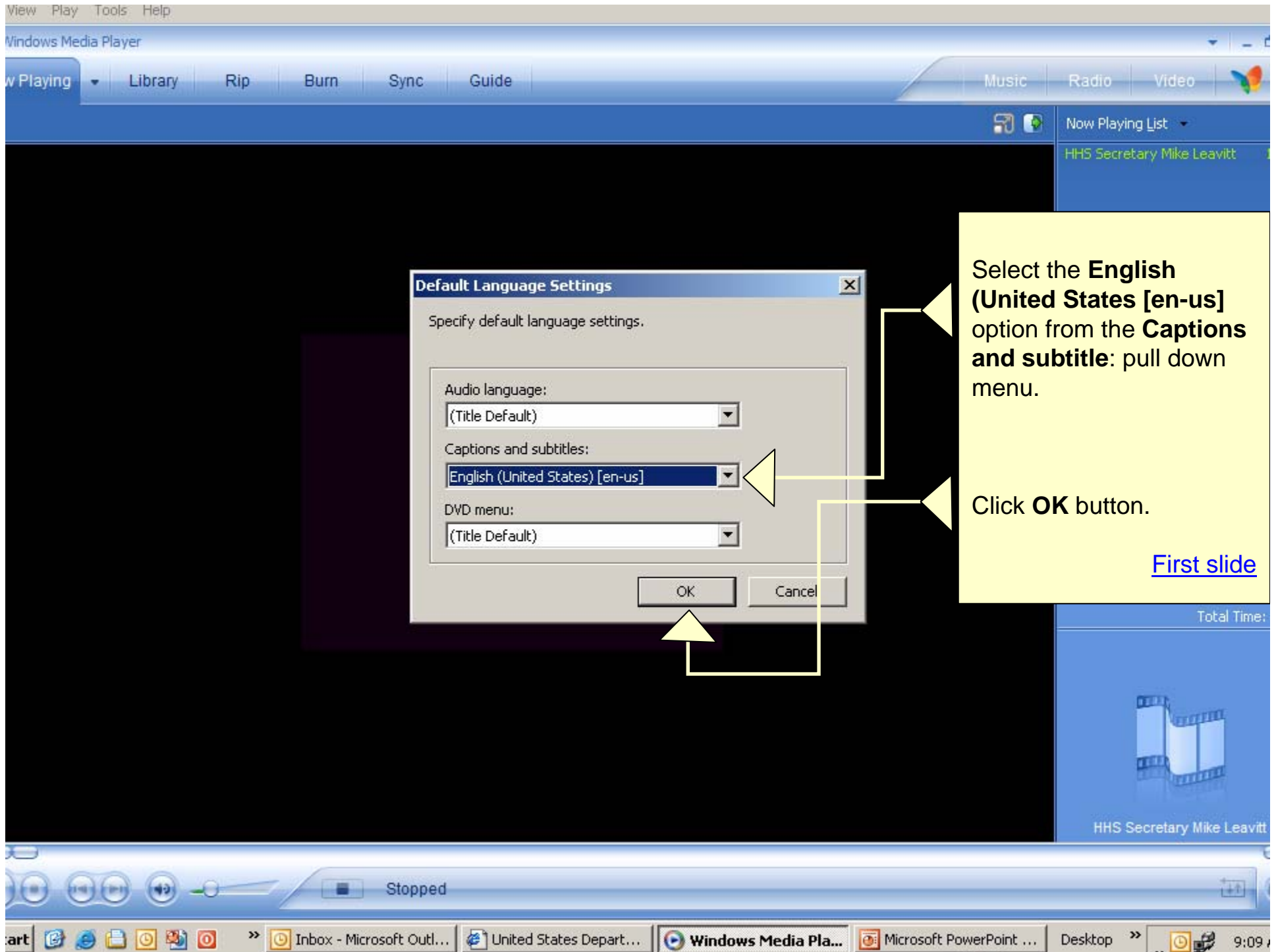
Windows Taskbar: Start, Internet Explorer, Microsoft PowerPoint, Windows Media Player, Desktop, 3:02 PM Monday
